


# The All-Knowing Salmon/Noogleshifty, Contemporary Irish Music for Silver Flute

Composed by Philippe Barnes and Tom Phelan, for Flute and Piano (2019, <a href="https://www.phillippebarnes.com">www.phillippebarnes.com</a>, 5'45" minutes)

This piece is a delight to play! It is available from the <u>GPFS Lending Library</u>, directly from the composer and through a few of our <u>GPFS Commercial Members and Sponsors</u> – Carolyn Nussbaum, Flute World and Flute Center of New York.



This playful Irish and jazz-influenced piece was transcribed from a recording of Barnes' and Phelan's studio session in Madrid, where they recorded original and re-imagined traditional melodies for a promo CD. Its enigmatic title was inspired by a T-shirt seen in a monastery gift shop referring to the Irish Myth of the "All-Knowing Salmon," as well as a nod to the Scottish band "Shooglenifty."

In the introductory notes on the piece, Barnes thoughtfully and thoroughly explains the techniques he employs to make the silver flute sound like an Irish wooden flute. These performance notes should not be overlooked. Such techniques include using flat fingers rather than curved,

eliminating vibrato and instead using finger vibrato, and utilizing both the first and second trill keys to add a little flick of ornamentation. To more fully explore the topic, he has written a book titled, "Trish Music on the Silver Flute."

The piece begins with a beautiful slow melody, then picks up speed in the "Noogleshifty" section where it has the more percussive feel of an Irish reel. A short jazzy interlude follows. It is written out, but the player is invited to improvise if they desire. The jazz techniques of overblowing the bending the notes are denoted. The last section is a variation on the "Noogleshifty" theme. The piece is appropriate for some advanced intermediate players, but more suited to advanced level players due to the recommended tempos and special effects. The length is just under six minutes long.
